

- HCA will work with you to conduct an assessment at your home and provide advice or recommendations on how to make your environment safer for the worker and yourself.
- Informing HCA if there are any animals or pets in your home, if you have changed something (locks, furniture arrangement) or if something is not working (e.g. a light bulb blown out, toilet not working), or anything else that you might have noticed after we have completed an assessment

HCA believes that health and wellbeing covers a broad range of area's for both you and our staff that will contribute to a holistic, fulfilled and well balanced lifestyle which includes

- Advocating on behalf of the customers that HCA deliver services to ensuring that your health and wellbeing needs are being addressed in an appropriate manner
- Ensuring that health and wellbeing needs and goals are included in your plan
- Ensuring that the plans are updated if changes occur
- Assisting customers to actively take control and lead, as far as possible the ongoing management of their general health and wellbeing
- Providing information on health and wellbeing that is reflective of your age, gender and also takes into consideration your cultural and spiritual beliefs in a non-judgemental manner
