Nurses require

- ✓ At least 4 years post-graduate experience
- ✓ 2 years dedicated to specialty nursing such as Emergency Department, Maternity or Aged Care
- ✓ Manual driver's licence
- ✓ Cannulation experience and confidence
- ✓ Understanding of culturally safe and inclusive practices.



Certifications required

These certifications ensure nurses are fully trained to manage emergencies, maternal health, pharmacological treatments, and immunisations, all vital in remote nursing environments.

Nurses require

- ✓ Advanced Life Support (ALS) - **Mandatory**
- ✓ Remote Emergency Care Course (REC) - **Mandatory**
- ✓ National Immunisation Program - **Mandatory**
- ✓ Maternity Emergency Care Course (MEC) - **Recommended**
- ✓ Pharmacotherapeutics - **Recommended**

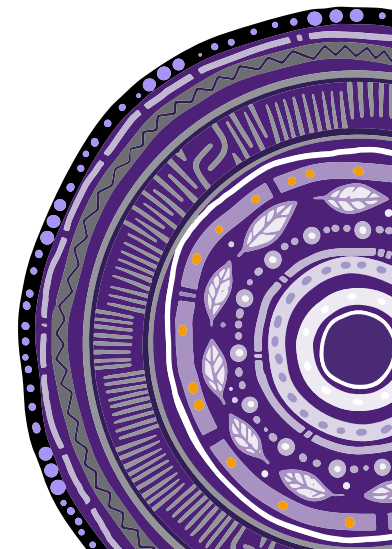

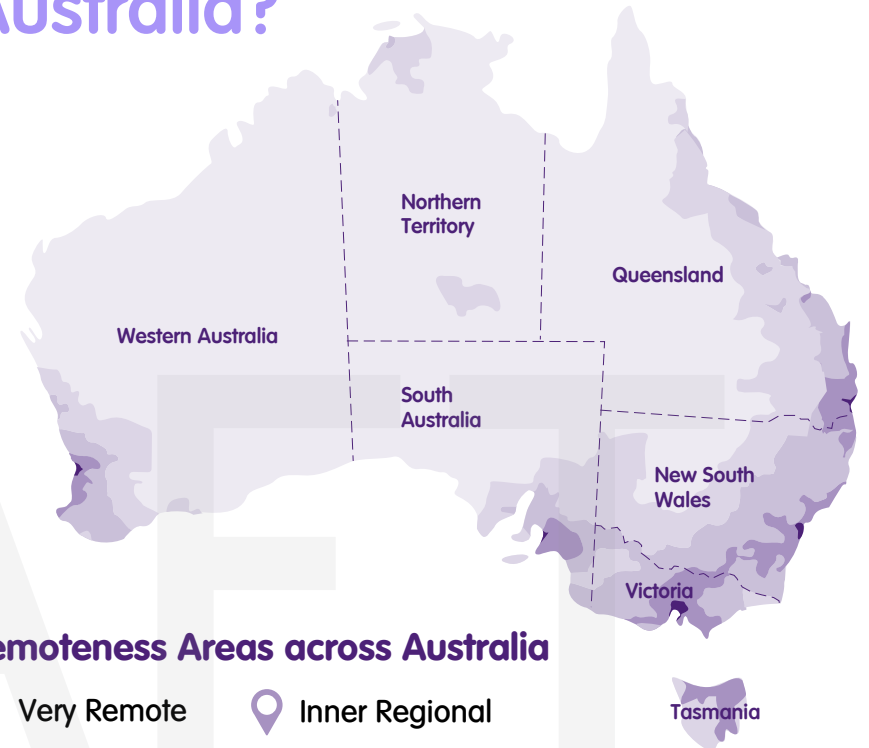

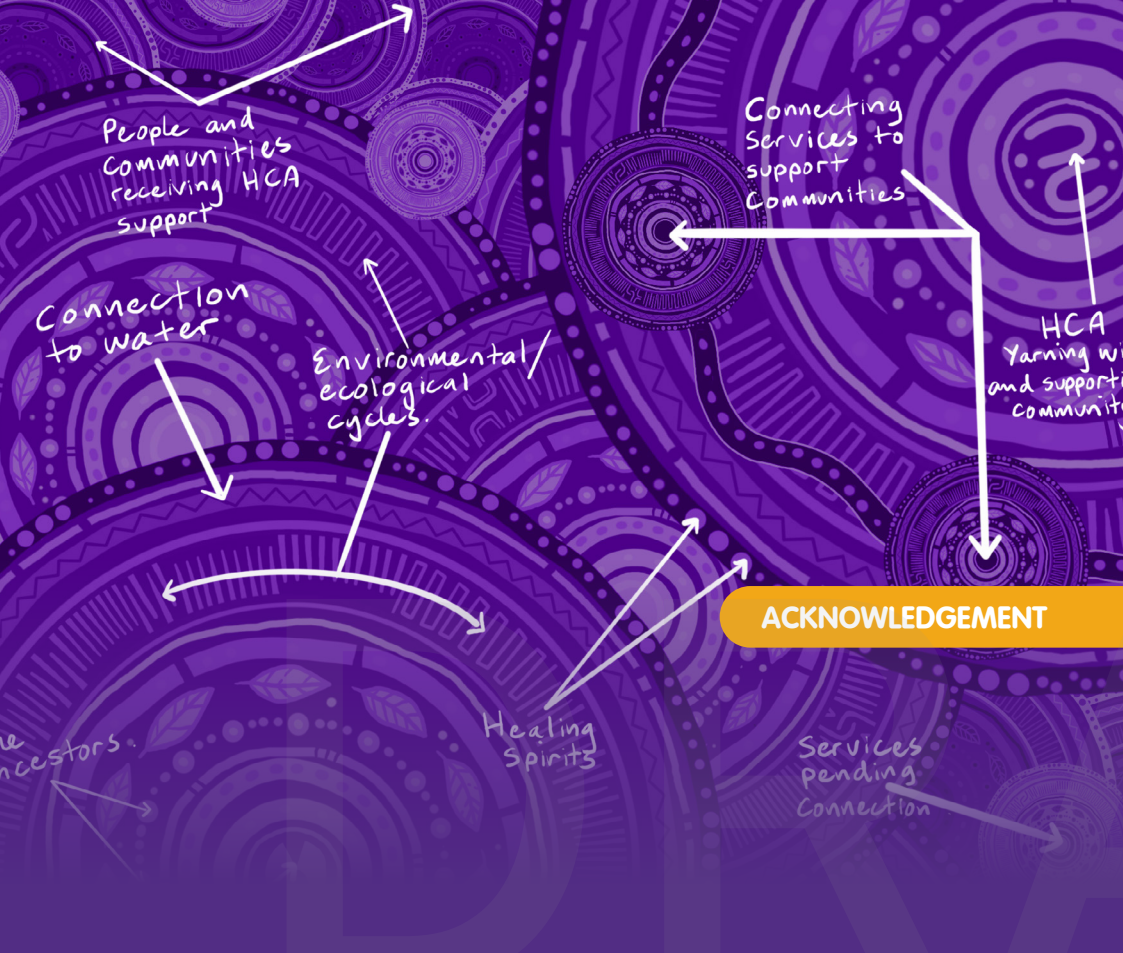
